
FISHING ON THE LODGE

Fishing on the lodge is permitted if you have a fishing rod licence – required to fish for salmon, trout, freshwater fish, smelt and eel caught with a rod and line.



This should be carried with you when fishing; failure to produce a licence, if asked, may result in a fine of up to £2,500.

Children under 13 don't need a licence. Adults helping or supervising must have a licence.

You will need the licence type for (non-migratory) 'trout, coarse fish and eel.' On reservoirs, lakes and ponds a licence will allow the use of 2 rods (3-rod licences available). Observe local byelaws.

There are no other charges. Once caught, fish must be freed and returned to the water. Clear-up after fishing and remove all litter.

Good practice: no barbed hooks, no braided line, no tins. No keepnets during 'Close Season' (spawning – 15/3 to 15/6).
